

## Easier SNAP Recertification for Eligible Seniors and People with Disabilities

Eligible households now recertify every three years — saving time while keeping your SNAP benefits active.

### What is SNAP ESAP\*?

A streamlined SNAP recertification process for eligible households with a three-year certification period and **simplified paperwork** at recertification.

### You might be eligible if:

Your household qualifies for SNAP 

All adults are **age 60+ and/or receiving disability benefits** 

No household adult earns income 

### How does SNAP ESAP work?



#### Automatic Enrollment

Eligible households are enrolled automatically during SNAP application or recertification.



#### Annual Reminders

Once a year, you'll get a flyer reminding you to report changes to your deductions.



#### Recertify Every 3 years

Stay enrolled for 3 years with less paperwork and no interview unless you ask for one.
