

## ACCOUNTABILITY FOR DRUG AND ALCOHOL ISSUES

in the New Hampshire Legislature  
2015-2016 Biennium

New Hampshire has seen its drug and alcohol problems reach epic proportions within the last few years. In 2015, [439 people died from drug overdoses](#).<sup>1</sup> The New Hampshire Chief Medical Examiner has projected that 494 Granite Staters will die in 2016 from drug overdoses.<sup>2</sup> In 2015 Narcan was administered 2,724 times.<sup>3</sup> Drug overdoses are just one indicator of the substance misuse epidemic we are facing. Approximately 103,000 New Hampshire residents are in need of treatment for substance use disorders.<sup>4</sup> We know that the rates of substance misuse by youth and young adults are some of the highest in the country and that substance misuse costs businesses nearly [\\$2 billion per year](#) in lost worker productivity, health care, public safety, and other miscellaneous expenses.<sup>5</sup>

New Futures believes that reducing alcohol and other drug problems in New Hampshire is a critical economic, public health and safety priority. It is important that New Hampshire voters have information about legislators' voting records on alcohol and other drug policy issues to make informed decisions. The New Hampshire General Court considered more than 1,800 bills in 2015-2016 biennium. Close to 140 of those bills dealt with alcohol and drug policy, and access to treatment issues.

In November of 2015, Governor Hassan asked the Executive Council to call an unprecedented special session of the legislature to address legislation aimed at strengthening the state's efforts to combat the heroin and opioid crisis and to help save lives. The legislature established a joint task force which recommended specific legislation to address the crisis.

In reviewing the activity of both legislative sessions, it is important to note that a significant majority of House and Senate bills were determined through voice vote, where an individual legislator's vote is not recorded. However, at other times, both the House and Senate have the ability to record the vote of each legislator on a bill through the roll call process. This report tracks 7 roll call votes in the Senate and 11 roll call votes in the House during the 2015 and 2016 legislative sessions. These bills raised important alcohol and other drug policy issues, as well as access to treatment issues.

The following chart uses a:

- ✓ To signify a vote supporting a policy to reduce alcohol and other drug problems.
- ✗ To signify a vote contrary to policy that would reduce alcohol and other drug problems.

“NV” for “No Vote” indicates that the legislator did not vote on that bill.

Senators and Representatives **in grey and in bold** are currently running for office.

## ALCOHOL POLICY

### 2015 – **HB 122: Relative to advertising of liquor or beverages**

**New Future opposed HB 122** because this legislation would qualify a long-standing restriction in RSA 179:31, VII(a) which prohibited references or pictures to minors in liquor or beverage advertising. The bill passed in both the House and Senate on previous votes, but Governor Hassan vetoed the bill due to the impact to minors. The veto was overridden by both the House and Senate and that restriction has been removed from state law. This law is counter to evidence based policy that alcohol advertising should not target or include youth.

### 2015 – **HB 554: Relative to sales of beer in refillable containers**

This bill would have authorized the sale of beer in refillable 64 ounce containers ("growlers") by both off premise and on premise licensees in New Hampshire. **New Futures opposed HB 554** because it would blur the distinction between on premise and off premise licenses and create wider access to alcohol "to go." Although the House passed this bill, it was later killed in the Senate and the measure did not become law.

## MARIJUANA POLICY

### 2015 – **HB 593: Permitting qualifying patients and registered caregivers to cultivate cannabis for therapeutic use**

HB 593 sought to amend the newly passed therapeutic cannabis law to permit patients and caregivers to grow their own marijuana. **New Futures opposed HB 593** because it would undermine the carefully crafted 2013 legislation, which has a regulatory structure designed to insure both patient health and public safety. Although the House passed this bill, it was referred to Interim Study in the Senate and it did not become law.

### 2015 – **HB 618: Relative to penalties for the possession of marijuana and relative to the cultivation of marijuana plants**

### 2016 – **HB 1631: Relative to penalties for possession of marijuana**

Both HB 618 (2015 session) and HB 1631 (2016 session) aimed to decriminalize the possession of one ounce of marijuana (40 – 60 joints). These bills would have also significantly reduced the criminal penalties for the cultivation of marijuana as well as for dealers involved in the sale and distribution of large quantities (five pounds or more) of marijuana. **New Futures opposed both bills** because they would increase access to, and use by, youth. It would also benefit dealers who distribute larger amounts of marijuana as well as growers by significantly reducing penalties for their illegal conduct. Although both bills passed the House they were defeated in the Senate and did not become law.

2016 – **HB 1694: Relative to the legalization and regulation of marijuana**

HB 1694 would have legalized possession of marijuana for persons over the age of 21 and legalized the cultivation of up to six marijuana plants. **New Futures opposed HB 1694** because it would expand access to, and the use of, a harmful substance which would result in adverse health and public safety consequences - particularly among youth. HB 1694 failed in the House.

## OTHER DRUGS

2015 – **SB 106: Restricting the sale or possession of synthetic drugs**

This bill prohibited the sale, use, or possession of synthetic drugs in this state. The bill also required the Governor's Commission on Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention, Treatment, and Recovery to make recommendations for public awareness and education on the dangers of synthetic drugs. **New Futures supported SB 106** because it was an appropriate response to the public health and safety problems resulting from synthetic drugs in our state. The bill passed both bodies and was signed into law by Governor Hassan.

2016 – **SB576: Relative to the penalty for possession and use of fentanyl-class drugs, insurance coverage for substance use disorders, the funding of the controlled drug prescription health and safety program, the membership of the board of medicine, and prescribers of controlled drugs**

This bills aimed at curbing the heroin and opioid crisis in New Hampshire and was recommended by the [Joint Task Force on the Heroin and Opioid Epidemic](#) in response to the heroin and opioid crisis. The bill signed into law takes several steps to help curb the heroin crisis, including: increasing penalties for the possession of heroin, removing private insurance barriers to addiction treatment services, allowing for expanded use of the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program and mandatory continuing education for all practitioners who possess a DEA license number. **New Futures supported SB 576** because of its comprehensive approach to the opioid epidemic. The bill passed both bodies and was signed into law by Governor Hassan.

# ACCESS TO TREATMENT

## 2016 – HB 1696 Relative to reauthorization of Medicaid Expansion

HB 1696 reauthorized and extended the New Hampshire Health Protection Program (NHHPP), also known as Medicaid Expansion, through 2018. **New Futures supported HB 1696** because Medicaid Expansion provides low-income individuals with access affordable to substance use disorder treatment. The substance use disorder benefit array available Medicaid Expansion beneficiaries is one of the most robust in the country, providing coverage for services ranging from outpatient and medication assisted treatment, to peer recovery supports and residential treatment services. Of the 50,000 NH residents enrolled in Medicaid Expansion, more than 6,000 have accessed the program's substance use disorder treatment benefit. The bill passed both bodies and was signed into law by Governor Hassan on April 5<sup>th</sup> of 2016.

## 2016 – SB 533: Relative to the Governor's Commission on Alcohol and Drug Abuse

SB 533 made a supplemental appropriation of \$2.5 million to the Governor's Commission on Alcohol and Other Drug Prevention, Treatment and Recovery, as well as an appropriation of \$2 million to the NH Housing Finance Authority for the development of recovery housing and they also appropriated \$500,000 to the Bureau of Drug and Alcohol Services to support New Hampshire recovery community organizations. **New Futures supported SB 533** because this bill provided the funding needed to support prevention, treatment and recovery initiatives throughout the state. This bill was also critical to advancing previously underfunded priorities listed in the Governor's Commission five year plan. The bill passed both bodies and was signed into law by Governor Hassan on June 24<sup>th</sup> of 2016.

## 2016 – SB 532: Prior authorization for substance use disorder treatment

SB 532 is the companion bill to SB 576, which removed prior authorization for outpatient addiction treatment. SB 532 filled a gap left by SB 576, removing similar barriers to acute *inpatient* addiction treatment and clinical stabilization services. **New Futures supported SB 532** because it allowed immediate access to clinically appropriate care for individuals with Substance Use Disorder. Due to the nature of Substance Use Disorder, it is imperative that individuals have access to treatment *as soon as they request it*. Any delay in treatment may be a missed opportunity for someone to initiate recovery. Without SB 532, health insurance carriers could continue to take anywhere from 24 to 72 hours to approve requests for critically needed inpatient treatment. The bill passed both bodies and signed into law by Governor Hassan on June 16<sup>th</sup> of 2016.
